Operation Resumption between Sakashita and Nojiri Stations on Chuo Line

Central Japan Railway Company will resume operations between Sakashita and Nojiri Stations of Chuo Line, which had been suspending its service as a result of the heavy rainfall on July 9 (Wed), 2014. All trains, including limited express train Wide View Shinano, will return to service from the first train of August 6 (Wed).
