

Passenger Volume during the Year-End and New Year Holidays in FY2023

(Tokaido Shinkansen and conventional lines: 8 days from December 28 to January 4)

1. Overview

During the year-end and New Year period of FY2023, train operations for eight days from December 28 to January 4 continued without any major transportation disruptions except for train delays on both the Shinkansen and conventional lines and partial suspension of service on conventional line limited express trains, such as Hida and Shirasagi, due to the impact of the 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake, which occurred on January 1.

The total passenger volume of the Shinkansen and limited express trains on the conventional lines was 3,178,000 and 148,000 during the period, respectively, and the total combined passenger volume of the Shinkansen and conventional lines was 3,326,000.

For outbound lines, the highest number of passengers was recorded on December 29 (Fri.) on the Shinkansen line and on December 30 (Sat.) on the conventional lines. For inbound lines, it was recorded on January 3 (Wed.) on both the Shinkansen and conventional lines.
