## Partial Changes to Our Free Wi-Fi Service

In light of recent changes in mobile data communication environments and customer usage trends, we will partially revise the provision of our public wireless LAN (free Wi-Fi) service as follows:

### 1. Applicable Service

Public wireless LAN service (free Wi-Fi service)

### 2. Details of the Changes

As of Tuesday, March 31, 2026, free Wi-Fi service will be discontinued at the following conventional line stations:

\* At the underlined stations (where Shinkansen and conventional lines are co-located), free Wi-Fi service will continue to be available near access points located around Shinkansen ticket gates and concourse waiting areas.

Tokaido Line: Mishima, Numazu, Fuji, Shimizu, Shizuoka, Takegawa, Aino, Hamamatsu,  
Toyohashi, Okazaki, Kariya, Gifu

Gotemba Line: Gotemba

Minobu Line: Fujinomiya

Chuo Line: Kanayama, Kozoji, Nakatsugawa, Nagiso, Agematsu, Kiso-Fukushima, Narai

Takayama Line: Gero, Hida-Furukawa

Kisei Line: Tsu

Sangu Line: Iseshi

\* Free Wi-Fi service will continue to be available at the following locations:

Tokaido Shinkansen: 17 stations (Tokyo to Shin-Osaka)

Conventional lines: 2 stations (Nagoya, Takayama)

\* Additionally, free Wi-Fi service will remain available on the Tokaido Shinkansen and the limited express trains "Hida" and "Nanki."

\* Please note that, depending on operational circumstances, the service end date may change at some stations.
