

Restrictions on waste receptacles and coin lockers along with G20 Osaka Summit

JR Central will take measures to strengthen several security measures in order for customers to safely use our services during the G20 Osaka Summit.

As part of these measures, restrictions will be placed on waste receptacles onboard Shinkansen trains and coin lockers at certain stations. Waste receptacles at certain stations will also be restricted.

These measures may be an inconvenience, but we ask for your understanding and cooperation as they are necessary for maintaining safety.

1. Restrictions on waste receptacles

(1) Waste receptacles onboard Shinkansen trains

(2) Waste receptacles at Shinkansen stations

Waste receptacles at certain Shinkansen stations will be made unavailable, most especially at Kyoto Station and Shin-Osaka Station which are located near the summit.
